Make the plan visible.

One useful page for a family, team, or group before anyone sends a portrait. Keep the brief broad, the permission clear, and the final audience named.

THE THREE DECISIONS

01 Purpose

What is this frame for: a keepsake, a card, a private group, or a public post?

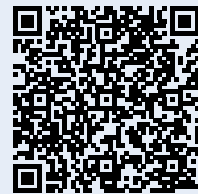
02 People

Who has opted in, and which portrait can each person share for this use?

03 Review

Who checks faces, hands, crop, disclosure, and audience before it travels?

SCAN FOR THE PRIVATE PLANNER

Catch the small errors.

A generated group image should feel intentional before it feels shareable. Use the six checks below with the people pictured and keep the source portraits in the channel you already trust.

SIX CHECKS BEFORE SHARING

- ☐ Every person recognizes themselves and has had a real chance to decline.
- ☐ Hands, faces, hair edges, eyes, and body scale look believable at phone size.
- ☐ The crop leaves every important face inside the intended print or social frame.
- ☐ The scene is labelled as AI-generated when someone could mistake it for documentary.
- ☐ The final audience, archive location, and removal owner are clear.
- ☐ No private portrait, name, or identifying detail has been added to a public brief.

A USEFUL STOP

If one check fails, pause the share. Fix the source or the wording, then ask the people pictured to review again.

Choose what happens next.

The plan is complete even if the group stops here. If everyone agrees, use the optional scene planner to turn permissioned portraits into one reviewable group image.

THREE CLEAN PATHS

Keep the plan

File this page with the event notes or send it to the person holding the camera.

Make the scene

Scan the QR code to choose a public scene and open the optional TogetherLens handoff.

Review together

Show the finished image to the people pictured before it leaves the agreed audience.
